Settlement reached: An Anaheim woman crippled when she was hit by a pickup truck while crossing a street in Stanton agreed to a structured settlement Wednesday that will pay her \$935,000 over her lifetime.

Barbara Reinhart suffered two broken legs when she was struck by a truck owned by the Arnold Wermes Dental Lab Inc., of Anaheim, and driven by Wermes' son, Barry, on Oct. 2, 1985, her attorney, Lawrence Eisenberg, said.

Reinhart was walking with her son across Magnolia Street when she was hit by the truck. Her son was not injured.

After four operations, Reinhart still must use crutches or a wheelchair to move about. Her lawsuit against the dental firm ended with the agreement Wednesday.

That settlement provides Reinhart with an immediate payment of \$350,000, with a lifetime monthly income of \$750 and interim lump sum payments, Eisenberg said.
